



4 Buffalo Trace only uses four mash recipes to craft the entirety of its whiskey portfolio.





50 The number of employees at Buffalo Trace in 1997, when the distillery was only producing at 6 percent of its capacity.




246 The number of years the Buffalo Trace Distillery has been in production, making it the oldest continuously-operating distillery in the United States.
