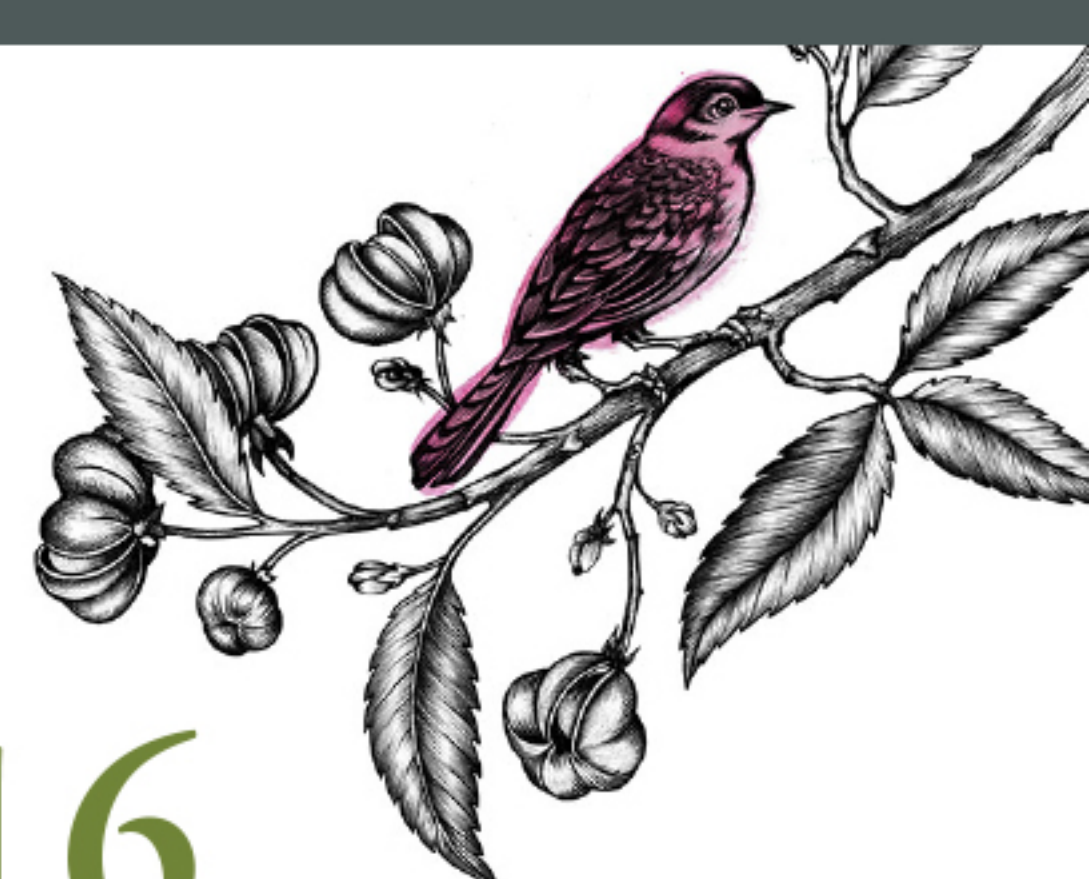

Bonterra is founded as an organic farm

Finely ground quartz is mixed with water and sprayed on the vines. The quartz helps catch light and encourages photosynthesis.



Sheep and chicken regularly visit the vineyard to eat pests, clear weeds, and help aerate the soil.

Farmers pack manure into

cow horns in the summer and bury them until the fall.

The matured manure is used as a fertilizer in the fields.



Cover crops planted between the rows of vines help protect against weeds, serve as a decoy for pests, and attract bees. At the end of the season, Bonterra composts these cover crops.

Bonterra works with Sola Bee farm to provide chemical-free sanctuary space for bee hives on the farm.



Bonterra's farmers spray the fields with teas and tinctures made from fresh or dried yarrow, chamomile, stinging nettle, oak bark, dandelion, and valerian to protect and support their vines.

Bonterra holds certifications from the California Certified Organic Farmers, Demeter USA, B Corp Labs, and the U.S. Zero Waste Business Council.
